## **Charging methods for credit tuition and miscellaneous fees, computer lab fees, and language lab fees for the 112 academic year**

**(2023 September – 2024 August)**

### **※ Credit tuition**

Article 1. Credit-based tuition and fees for Bachelor's degree courses, extension students, elective students

Credit-based tuition and miscellaneous fees =

Number of hours studied per week × School of Humanities NTD 1,309

× School of Finance and Economics NTD 1,319

Article 2. In-service master's degree program of Department of Business Management

Credit-based tuition and miscellaneous fees = number of hours studied per week × 7,140 NTD  
+ miscellaneous fees 10,000 NTD

Article 3. In-service master's program of Department of Religious Culture and Information Management

Tuition and miscellaneous fees = tuition fee 39,960 NTD + miscellaneous fees 8,040 NTD

Credit-based tuition and miscellaneous fees for extension students = number of hours per week  
× 3,000NTD + miscellaneous fees of 8,040 NTD

Note:

(1) After adding or withdrawing, the tuition fee will be paid or refunded based on the actual number of hours taken.  
The date for tuition refund will be announced separately by the school.

(2) Day students who take extended courses for more than 10 hours (inclusive) are required to pay full tuition and miscellaneous fees (including tuition, miscellaneous fees and insurance premiums).

(3) There is no credit fee for thesis extension for in-service master's degree students in the Department of Business Administration, only miscellaneous fees; however, credit fees and miscellaneous fees (i.e. credit-based tuition and miscellaneous fees) are charged for subject extension.

There are no tuition and miscellaneous fees for extended thesis studies for master's degree students, but credit-based tuition and miscellaneous fees are required for subject extensions (the charging standard is the same as that of the bachelor's degree program).

(4) Courses with fewer credits than the number of class hours will be calculated based on the number of class hours per week.

(5) There is no charge for elective courses from in-service special classes to undergraduate courses for the Master of Business Administration. Those that do not count for credits are free of charge, but those that count for credits are charged.

Except for the in-service master's class in the Department of Business Management, there is no charge for elective courses at the undergraduate level.

(6) This charging method has been reviewed and approved by the school council meeting.

### **※ Computer lab fees charging method**

Article 1. Computer lab fees will be charged for freshman information literacy subjects, and all courses will be implemented in computer classrooms; for the implementation of each other subject course, if the computer classroom is used for more than 2 weeks each semester, computer internship fees will be charged, and classes will be arranged throughout the semester for using the computer classroom. For subjects that do not charge computer internship fees, the courses can be taught in the computer classroom during the free time after classes are scheduled, up to 2 weeks.

Article 2. Fees are calculated based on the number of hours of elective courses taken in the semester. The standards are as follows:

The first 2 hours, 500NTD per hour; the 3rd and 4th hours, 250 NTD per hour; starting from the 5th hour, 125 NTD per hour.

Article 3. The standards for additions, withdrawals, supplementary refunds, etc. are calculated from the last hour.

Note:

- (1) All repair courses will be charged.
- (2) The school will announce the additional refund date after withdrawal.
- (3) Regardless of whether students have paid the computer internship fee, they can use the personal computers in the computer free classroom during open hours outside of class.
- (4) This charging method has been reviewed and approved by the school executive meeting.

## ※ Language lab fees charging method

Article 1. Language lab fees will be charged for freshman language training subjects, and all courses will be implemented in language training classrooms; for the implementation of each other subject course, if the language training classroom is used for more than 2 weeks each semester, language teaching internship fees will be charged, and Arrange to use the language training classroom for classes throughout the semester. For subjects that do not charge language teaching internship fees, the courses can be taught in the language training classroom during the free time after the scheduled class, up to 2 weeks.

Article 2. Fees are calculated based on the number of hours of elective courses taken in the semester. The standards are as follows:

The first 2 hours are 330 NTD per hour; the 3rd and 4th hours are 165 NTD per hour; and from the 5th hour onwards, the price is 82 NTD per hour.

Article 3. The standards for additions, withdrawals, supplementary refunds, etc. are calculated from the last hour.

Note:

- (1) All repair courses will be charged.
- (2) The school will announce the additional refund date after withdrawal.
- (3) Students can use the language lab during open hours regardless of whether they have paid the language lab fee.
- (4) This charging method has been reviewed and approved by the school executive meeting.
